c. Eligibility for Master's Program:

The applicant should:

- i. Be between 25 and 40 years as of April 1st, 2021 (born on/after April 2nd, 1980 and born on/before April 1st, 1996)
- ii. Possess bachelor degree authorized by the Government of Pakistan
- iii. Have 16 years of formal education in principle, however, relevant academic/research career or working experience can be considered as the alternative to meet the requirement

d. Eligibility for PhD Program:

The applicant should:

- i. Be between 25 and 45 years as of April 1st, 2021 (born on/after April 2nd, 1980 and born on/before April 1st, 1996)
- ii. Have Master's Degree issued by a Japanese university
- iii. Have a recommendation from supervisor of current duty officer
- iv. Have a recommendation from expected academic adviser(s) of the applying university in Japan

- 3. All Ministries/Divisions/ Departments are requested to send nominations of suitable officers who fulfill the eligibility criteria mentioned above to the undersigned by 10-11-2020 along with two (2) copies of prescribed JDS Application forms, one copy of each surety bond, undertaking, CNIC, Passport.
