Notes

Yunnan International Center for Economic and Technical Exchanges (YICETE), since approved as one of training bases for international business officials by MOFCOM in 2014, has successfully organized 162 seminars sponsored by MOFCOM and People's Government of Yunnan Province, and has trained 4,113 government officials at various levels from 102 developing countries (including 11 officials at ministerial level and 169 at director-general level). About the Organizer

The School of Rehabilitation, Kunming Medical University is the co-organizer of the seminar. The School of Rehabilitation, Kunming Medical University, formerly known as the major of rehabilitation therapy set up in 2005 in Kunming Medical University and inaugurated on November 24, 2016, is consisted of 6 undergraduate programs of rehabilitation therapy, rehabilitation physical therapy, rehabilitation occupational therapy, hearing and speech rehabilitation, sports rehabilitation and prosthetics and orthopedics engineering. In addition, it has set up 3 degree programs in the secondary disciplines of rehabilitation medicine and physiotherapy, rehabilitation science and hearing and speech rehabilitation for full-time and in-service graduate students. At present, a total of 856 fulltime undergraduate, graduate and doctoral candidates are enrolled. undergraduates and more than 100 master's and doctoral graduates have been trained. Majors of rehabilitation physical therapy and rehabilitation occupational therapy have passed the international certification and rehabilitation certification, and become the national first-class professional construction station, with the soft ranking to be A+; the major of hearing and speech rehabilitation has become the provincial first-class professional construction station, with the soft ranking to be B. The School has employed 4 foreign part-time faculty heads, 2 honorary professors, 18 guest professors, and 67 full-time and part-time teachers, including 2 winning the title of "Yunling Distinguished Teacher", 10 professors and associate professors, 4 doctoral supervisors, and 13 master's supervisors. All teachers of the School have studied abroad, and have obtained the master's or doctor's degree.
