The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that the Japan International Cooperation Agency has offered fully funded **one seat** subject training course scheduled to be held **w.e.f July 18, 2026 to August 08, 2026 in Japan and w.e.f September 07 & 08, 2026 online follow-up program**. All the concerned Ministries / Divisions / Departments are requested to send nomination of the suitable officer who fulfills the criteria to the undersigned by **16-04-2026** along with three (3) copies of prescribed JICA's application form, CNIC, Passport, FTC Performa English Score Sheet and Questionnaire as advised in the [G.I. Booklet](#).

Course Objective:

The Action Plan will be developed to improve the health and wellbeing of women and adolescents and it will be proposed to the organizations to which the participants belong.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be an officer responsible for planning / designing maternal, newborn and child health (MNCH) programs.
- Have a minimum of 3 years' experience in planning, administration, implementation and monitoring / evaluation in the field of MNCH and /or reproductive health.
- Have command of spoken and written of English
- Be Between the age of 30 and 50 years
- Must be in good health, pregnancy may lead to health problems.
- Female candidates are encouraged to apply for the course
