SUBJECT: ROK KAU 2026 KOREA S FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME ON GLOBAL AVIATION POLICY MASTER OF SCIENCE IN AVIATION POLICY AT KOREA AEROSPACE UNIVERSITY FROM AUGUST 01, 2026 TO DECEMBER 17, 2027

The undersigned is directed to inform that the Embassy of the Republic of Korea has invited nominations for the above **Fully Funded** Fellowship Programme to be held from **August 01, 2026 to December 17, 2027** at Republic of Korea. 2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria:-

- Be permanent government employee (BS-17 or above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Must be a government or public sector employee **working in the field of aviation.**
- Health: Must be in good physical and mental health.
- Education: Must have completed a bachelor's degree or hold an equivalent qualification from a college or university.
- English Proficiency: Must have strong command of both spoken and written English, sufficient to take courses conducted entirely in English and to write academic reports and a thesis.
- Scholarship History: Must not have previously participated in or withdrawn from any Korean Government Scholarship Program..

Objectives:

- To provide high-quality education for the aviation practitioners and professionals from developing countries, offering theoretical and practical knowledge and skills in the fields of (a) aviation policy and management and (b) aviation and airport operation;
- To cultivate a pool of future international experts who can actively engage in and play meaningful roles in the international aviation sector,
- To conduct academic research to improve understanding of the mechanisms in the international aviation sector and policy dynamics in each participating country.

- To share Korea's development experience, which can be practically applied to endeavors aimed at achieving economic development and improving conditions in airports and the aviation sector in the participant's country;
- To establish cooperative relationships between Korea and partner countries through the global network of international aviation, and to nurture pro-Korean leaders in the global arena.

10. Curriculum Vitae (CV)
11. Certificate of Employment: Must indicate your position and exact employment period (start and end dates).
12. Copy of Passport: The expiry date should be later than the end date of the program.
13. Certificate of English proficiency (if applicable): Please submit a score report from a recognized English Proficiency Test (e.g., TOEFL, TEPS, IELTS) or any other supporting documents that demonstrate appropriate English language proficiency.

4. Incomplete/late submission of documents/nomination will not be accepted. Moreover, any deliberate provision of wrong information on the part of the candidate shall be viewed seriously.
