SUBJECT: TRAINING COURSE ON CAPACITY BUILDING OF PAKISTAN CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY FOR TRAINING OF TRAINERS IN ENGINEERING SERVICES RESCUE AND FIREFIGHTING SERVICES AND AIR TRAFFIC SERVICES FROM 10 AUGUST TO 21 AUGUST, 2026 IN KOREA

The undersigned is directed to inform that the Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) has invited nominations for the above **Fully Funded** Training Programme to be held at Republic of Korea. 2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria:-

- Be permanent government employee (BS-17 or above) director-level, managerial, or working-level position nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Officials from the Rescue, Firefighting, Airport Security, and Aviation Safety Divisions of Pakistan Airports Authority (PAA) and related agencies
- Must be affiliated with the Pakistan Civil Aviation Authority (PCAA) or related government agencies, and nominated by their department heads.
- Should be proficient in English, have not participated in a similar KOICA Fellowship Program in the past three years.
- Possess basic computer skills, have at least three years of work experience, and ensure that 45% of the nominees are female.

Objectives:

- To strengthen the capacities of PAA officials and the aviation safety professionals in rescue, firefighting, airport security, and aviation safety management.
- To support the establishment of practical safety, security, and emergency response systems in line with ICAO standards.
- To provide practical training in aircraft rescue and firefighting services, airport security, aviation safety management, and related field operations.
- To transfer relevant knowledge and build cooperative networks for the implementation of sustainable training programs within PAA.

3. Nominations of suitable candidates fulfilling the laid-down eligibility criteria prescribed by the sponsoring agency duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry by the close of business hours **June 1, 2026** positively:
