About the Organizer	<p>The National Judges College (NJC) is an institution directly affiliated to the Supreme People's Court and a main institution for judicial education and training in China. Founded in 1997, NJC is located at No. 111, West Road of South 4th Ring Road, Huaxiang, Fengtai District, Beijing. It covers an area of 248 mu (about 16.53 hectares) and has a floor area of 65,000 m<sup>2</sup>, with the capacity to train up to 700 participants simultaneously.</p> <p>The college is primarily responsible for providing appointment, reappointment, promotion, and specialized trial-related training for presidents and vice-presidents of China's high people's courts and intermediate people's courts, as well as for senior judges and reserve judicial talents at all levels of the people's courts. It also offers pre-service training for newly appointed judges. In recognition of its performance, the NJC has received commendations from the Supreme People's Court in 2011, 2013, 2014, 2018, 2022, and 2023, and was awarded by the Supreme People's Court a collective third-class merit in 2015.</p> <p>NJC boasts an excellent full-time and part-time faculty, with 27 full-time teachers, including 10 professors, 6 associate professors and 11 lecturers. At the same time, more than 300 part-time teachers are employed from people's courts at all levels, as well as from educational and research institutions and government agencies nationwide. To date, NJC has established 33 branches across China's provinces, autonomous regions, and municipalities.</p> <p>NJC serves as a key platform for international exchanges under the Supreme People's Court and functions as "the International Exchange Center for Judges of the Supreme People's Court". In alignment with the Belt and Road Initiative, as of March 2026, the National Judges College had organised a total of 106 seminars for judges from overseas, including 15 online sessions, training more than 2,600 judicial officials from over 90 countries and regions.</p>	
Training content	<p>This seminar aims to implement Xi Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era, promote the implementation of the Belt and Road Initiative, implement a series of talent training initiatives announced by President Xi Jinping at major international events, deepen international cooperation in the field of justice and build a platform for judicial exchanges and cooperation between China and other countries in the world.</p> <p>The seminar will provide a series of lectures covering topics such as China's national conditions, the rule of law in Chinese path to modernization, China's court organization and judge system, China's civil and commercial trial system, China's criminal trial system, China's administrative trial system, China's traditional culture and other contents, helping the participants understand the socialist legal system with Chinese characteristics.</p> <p>The keynote speakers will include senior judges from various divisions of the Supreme People's Court, the President, Vice President, and professors of the NJC as well as law professors from well-known universities. The seminar will include visits to primary people's courts, where participants can observe court hearings and engage in discussions with judges to gain insights into China's judicial procedures and system. In addition, the participants may also visit specialized courts and intermediate people's courts for thematic exchanges and discussions.</p> <p>Participants will also have the opportunity to take study tours outside the host city. These tours will include visits to local courts for further exchanges and seminars, as well as trips to cultural heritage sites and enterprises.</p>

About the Organizer	<p>Jiangsu Inspection and Quarantine Institute of Quality (hereinafter referred to as JSIQ) was established in 2005 and affiliated with Nanjing Customs District, China. It has been organizing foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China. JSIQ is a scientific research institution engaged in quality research, international exchanges, comprehensive training and management consultation. It currently consists of departments including the Planning and Development Department, the International Exchange and Training Department, and the General Administration Department, with a staff of over 20 full-time employees.</p> <p>JSIQ started to organize foreign-aid training programs sponsored by the Ministry of Commerce of China since 2006, and has organized 332 programs successfully by the end of 2025. Over 9000 customs officials, technicians and participants from other authorities of 154 countries and international organizations from five continents received training during these programs. About the Organizer	<p>China Women’s University (CWU) is affiliated to the All-China Women’s Federation (ACWF). Since its establishment in 1949, the university has adhered to the socialist orientation in running schools, implemented the Party’s education policy, followed the laws of higher education development, implemented the Basic National Policy of Gender Equality, and always kept pace with the national economic and social development, the development of higher education and the development of women’s progress in the world. CWU has always been committed to cultivating intellectual and elegant applied female talents with gender awareness, public welfare consciousness, and an international perspective. On December 31, 2019, China Women’s University was officially designated as the ACWF Executive Leadership Academy, marking a new chapter in the training of women cadres both domestically and internationally. On April 29, 2024, the China International Development Cooperation Agency (CIDCA) and the ACWF jointly unveiled the “Exchange and Training Base of Global Women’s Development Cooperation” at China Women’s University. On October 13, 2025, President Xi Jinping attended the opening ceremony of the Global Leaders’ Meeting on Women and delivered the keynote address, announcing that China would establish a Global Center for Women’s Capacity Building, which is aimed at conducting capacity building and other development cooperation with relevant countries and international organizations to train more female talent. On the afternoon of October 14, 2025, the unveiling ceremony of Global Center for Women’s Capacity Building was held at China Women’s University.</p> <p>CWU has the foundation, resources, advantages, and experience in training female officials from developing countries. Since 2013, CWU has started to undertake the short-term training programs of the Ministry of Commerce. To date, it has held 44 seminars (including five online seminars between 2021 and 2022) on Leadership of Women Officials in Developing Countries, Capacity of Social Management, Women’s Capacity Building, etc. A total of 1403 officials from 101 countries and two international organizations have participated in the training and study online and offline. The seminars have been highly complimented by participants and have made good effects. Since 2016, CWU has undertaken the international program of Master of Social Work in Women’s Leadership and Social Development. On May 30, 2019, President Xi Jinping’s wife Professor Peng Liyuan cordially met with 50 current master’s students from 23 countries and encouraged them to become bridges and ties connecting China and their respective countries when they return home. CWU has a team of faculty members who are proficient in teaching in English, have a background of studying or visiting abroad, and possess solid professional knowledge and capabilities, as well as rich experience in foreign assistance training programs. The foreign assistance training programs of CWU has received great attention and careful guidance from the higher-level competent departments such as the Ministry of Commerce, the ACWF, the CIDCA and the Academy for International Business Officials (AIBO), Ministry of Commerce. Main training content  Epidemiology and Development Trends: Historical prevalence and evolving trends of structural heart disease globally and in China; R&amp;D progress and current domestic/international application status of China's original ultrasound-guided interventional techniques; establishment and promotion of the ultrasound-guided interventional technology system; R&amp;D concepts and advancements in related devices and equipment; clinical research and evaluation of ultrasound-guided interventional techniques.  Clinical Applications and Indications: Advances in ultrasound for interventional therapy; indications for ultrasound-guided interventional techniques, including applications in common valvular heart diseases (aortic valve, mitral valve, tricuspid valve, etc.). Key focus on indications, contraindications, and application strategies for transcatheter aortic valve implantation/replacement (TAVI/TAVR), transcatheter edge-to-edge repair (TEER), and transcatheter tricuspid valve repair/replacement. In the speech, he announced eight major steps that China will take to support the joint pursuit of high-quality Belt and Road cooperation. He stressed that China stands ready to deepen Belt and Road partnerships of cooperation with all parties, usher Belt and Road cooperation into a new stage of high-quality development, and make relentless efforts to achieve modernization for all countries.</p> <p>China is part of the big Eurasian family, and China’s development is inseparable from the overall development of Eurasia. China will speed up the high-quality development of the China-Europe Railway Express, take part in the development of the Trans-Caspian International Transport Corridor, and host the China-Europe Railway Express International</p>

Cooperation Forum. Together with all parties, China will build a new logistics corridor across the Eurasian continent supported by direct railway and road transportation. China will vigorously promote the integrated development of ports, shipping and trade under the Silk Road Maritime initiative, and accelerate the development of the New International Land-Sea Trade Corridor and the Air Silk Road.

Purpose: This seminar aims to introduce China's management experience in economic connectivity, build a technical exchange platform for countries along Economic Corridors in the field of connectivity, enhance the capacity of these countries in transport infrastructure and connectivity development, and further promote friendly relations among countries along the Economic Corridor.

- (1) General Courses: A Brief Introduction to China, China's Interaction with the World, etc.
