

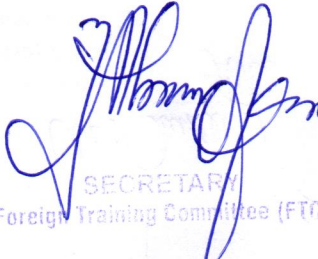

Subject: Minutes of the Meeting of Foreign Training Committee (FTC) held on 03rd July, 2026

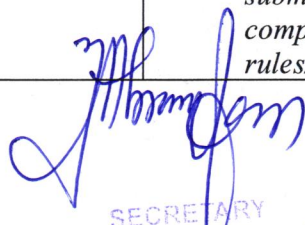
