About the Organizer	<p>Located in the central part of Shaanxi Province, Yangling Demonstration Zone is about 80 km away from Xi'an City and approximately a one-hour drive from Xi'an Xianyang International Airport. Established in 1997, it is the first National Agricultural High-Tech Industrial Demonstration Zone in China. It is also the CHINA AID Dryland Farming Technology Training Center founded by the Ministry of Commerce, the SCO Demonstration Base for Agricultural Technology Exchange and Training, and the China-Africa Joint Center for Modern Agrotechnology Exchange, Demonstration and Training (Shaanxi). As one of the regions with the most concentrated agricultural science and education resources in China, Yangling is home to more than 110 provincial and ministerial-level scientific research platforms, including the Institute of Soil and Water Conservation, Chinese Academy of Sciences and Institute of Water-Saving Agriculture in Arid Areas of China. These platforms cover more than 70 disciplines related to agriculture, forestry and water conservancy, and bring together more than 7,000 professional talents in agricultural sciences.</p> <p>The International Exchange Center of Yangling Demonstration Zone is the main department undertaking the training programs and international exchanges. Since 2005, it has undertaken more than 190 training programs of various areas, with over 5,600 participants from more than 130 countries participating in training in Yangling. Relying on the strong scientific and educational resources of Northwest A&amp;F University, Xi'an Jiaotong University, the Institute of Soil and Water Conservation (Chinese Academy of Sciences and Ministry of Water Resources), the National Beef Cattle Improvement Center and other institutions in Shaanxi Province, the Center has developed 10 distinctive training areas, focusing on agricultural economic management, facility agriculture, water-saving irrigation, soil and water conservation, animal husbandry, e-commerce, public infrastructure construction, governance capacity building, poverty alleviation cooperation, etc. It has established a part-time and full-time teaching team composed of more than 150 experts in modern agriculture, animal husbandry, e-commerce and other fields, and built more than 20 practical training bases covering economic forestry, facility agriculture, crop cultivation and other fields. The Center boasts a solid foundation and extensive experience in organizing training programs in agriculture and related fields.</p>	
Training content	<p>1. Main training content</p> <p>(1) China's National Conditions and Culture: Introduction to China's national geography and population profile, history, basic political system, traditional Chinese culture, and folk customs.</p> <p>(2) Xi Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era: Introduction to Xi Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era, explaining its core tenets, historical context, and practical directions.</p> <p>(3) Modern Meat Processing and High-Quality Industrial Development: This session introduces the current development status of China's meat processing industry, industrial scale, mainstream processing technologies, and industry development trends.</p> <p>(4) Modern Dairy Processing and High-Quality Industrial Development: This session</p>	

introduces the current development status of China's dairy processing industry, industry technology research and development, large-scale operation, upstream and downstream industrial chain integration, and representative leading enterprises.

(5) Food Preservation Technologies and Quality Control: This session introduces the current status of international food preservation technologies and industrial development prospects, analyzing the application of key technologies in food preservation and processing, as well as related infrastructure development.

(6) Storage Technologies and Applications for Major Fruits and Vegetables: This session introduces the post-harvest physiological and biochemical characteristics of major fruits and vegetables, practical storage applications in China, and related industrial chain development.

(7) Types and Applications of Fruit and Vegetable Processing Technologies: This session introduces the development history of China's fruit and vegetable processing industry, new technologies for deep processing, and their practical applications.

(8) Cold Sterilization Technologies for Fruits and Vegetables and Their Applications: This session introduces the application scenarios and technical advantages of different types of cold sterilization technologies, as well as their role in the high-quality development of the food industry.

(9) Grain and Oil Processing Industry Chain and China's Development Model: This session introduces the structure of China's grain and oil processing industry chain, development models in raw material organization, processing system construction, product development, and market supply.

(10) Grain and Oil Product Processing, Quality Control, and Food Application Cases: This session introduces technology development, standardized management, quality control, and brand building in the grain and oil processing industry by using edible oils as an example.

## 2. Arrangements for the Study Tour (The Visit City May Be Adjusted According to the Actual Situation)

(1) Participants will be arranged to visit Aiju Cereal and Oil Industrial Group Co., Ltd. in Xi'an, Shaanxi province, to learn about modern intelligent grain and oil processing production operations, quality control systems, grain logistics, the integrated development model of primary, secondary, and tertiary industries, and practical experience in Belt and Road international cooperation.

(2) Participants will be arranged to visit Jinshahe Noodle Co., Ltd. in Xianyang, Shaanxi province, to learn about the intelligent wheat milling and whole-process noodle production line, automated packaging, and staple food processing technologies.

In addition, cultural experience activities and field visits in cities including Beijing and Xi'an will be arranged for participants in accordance with project requirements.

(1) Ding Wu: Professor, College of Food Science and Engineering, Northwest A&F University. His research directions include animal product processing and high-value utilization.

(2) Kou Liping: Associate Professor, College of Food Science and Engineering, Northwest A&F University. Her research directions include food safety preservation and logistics.

(3) Li Mei: Associate Professor, College of Food Science and Engineering, Northwest A&F University. Her research directions include fruit and vegetable processing and high-value utilization.

(4) Zhang Siyu: Associate Professor, College of Food Science and Engineering, Northwest A&F University. His research directions include grain and oil processing.

6.Development and Practice of E-commerce for Agricultural Products in China: including the emergence and development of e-commerce for agricultural products in China, the main models and the operational models of vertical fresh produce e-commerce platforms, etc.
