SUBJECT: PROMOTION OF HYDROPOWER DEVELOPMENT

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject and state that the Japan International Cooperation Agency has offered fully funded **one seat** for the subject training course scheduled to be held w.e.f. **October 25, 2026 to November 20, 2026 in Japan**. All concerned Ministries / Divisions / Departments are requested to send nomination of suitable officer who fulfills the criteria to the undersigned by **17-08-2026** along with three (3) copies of prescribed JICA application form, surety bond, undertaking, CNIC, FTC Performa, and Passport as advised in the [G.I. Booklet](#).

Course Objective:

Hydropower government agencies and electric utilities acquire knowledge and experience from Japan, share these insights within their home organizations, and network with Japanese counterparts to drive sustainable hydropower development in their respective countries.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be responsible (officer, Engineer or Researcher etc) for hydropower development and those currently posted to the managerial position in the government agencies or electric power utilities which are in charge of the development of hydropower generation.
- Have at least 5 years of practical experience in the field of hydropower development.
- Be graduate of engineering university.
- Be less than 45 years of age.
- Female are encouraged to apply for the training course.


