Booklet](#) uploaded on EAD's website.

Course Objective:

This course aims to learn comprehensive approach under the government initiatives to promote livestock production by transforming more profitable and resilient livestock production while considering sustainable livestock farming, improving the living standards of livestock farmers through improving cattle productivity.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be working on livestock development and extension as a veterinarian, livestock officer, researcher or a technician in governmental institutes, veterinary offices, agriculture offices or research centers, at national/regional /district level.
- Have more than 5 years' experience in livestock development and extension.
- Be graduate of university
- Be between age of 30 to 45 years
- Have command of spoken and written English
- Women are encouraged to apply for the course.


