SUBJECT: COUNTER INTERNATIONAL TERRORISM

Course Objective:

To learn and be able to explain the countermeasures against international terrorism in Japan. To establish close cooperative relationship among participating countries in order to promote information exchange in the field of international terrorism prevention.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

- Be a high-ranking officer from National Police, Ministry of Interior or intelligence service in charge of counter terrorism or terrorism investigation assuming a position equivalent to Director or higher and is currently engaged in collecting and analyzing information on international terrorism, or in investigation of international terrorism incidents.
- Be university graduates or the equivalent thereof;
- Women are encouraged to apply for the course.
- Have command of spoken and written English.
- Must be in good health.

2. New prescribed JICA's Application forms along and specimen of surety bond, undertaking and FTC Performa can be downloaded from EAD's website www.ead.gov.pk under "Foreign Trainings" link in "Forms" ad also available on JICA's website www.jica.go.jp/pakistan/english/index.html.

3. In case of selection of officer, the concerned Ministries/Division/Department are requested to ensure timely relieving of the officer along with NoC. Furthermore, the concerned officer may be directed to submit **Post-Visit Training Report** to this Ministry on priority basis.
