SUBJECT: UPGRADING PRACTICAL SKILLS FOR VETERINARY OFFICERS IN LIVESTOCK HEALTH SERVICES

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that Japan International Cooperation Agency has offered fully funded **one seat** for the subject training course scheduled to be held w.e.f. **June 22, 2026 to July 21, 2026 Pre-Online and w.e.f July 22, 2026 to August 19, 2026 in Japan**. All concerned Ministries / Divisions / Departments are requested to send nomination of a suitable officers who fulfills the criteria to the undersigned by **24-04-2026** along with three copies of prescribed JICA forms, CNIC, Passport, FTC Performa, undertaking & surety bond as advised in the [G.I. Course Objective:

Participants learn practical techniques and concepts of clinical diagnosis, initial response, and prevention of livestock diseases in the field and create concrete Action plan in order to incorporate the animal health policies of each country into the field-level veterinary services.

Eligibility Criteria: -

The applicant should:

Be Veterinary officers of professionals working on animal health services and continuing education of frontline veterinary and para-veterinary practitioners.

Have more than 3 years' experience in the field

Be Between the age of 25 and 50 years

Must be in good health


Have command of spoken and written English

Have basic computer skills

Female candidates are encouraged to apply for the course.


